WHEREAS, during the month of October we urge our citizens to support programs in our community that highlight domestic violence awareness issues, and educate themselves about the problem of domestic violence; and


WHEREAS, children that grow up in violent homes are believed to be abused and neglected at a rate higher than the national average; and
