To All To Whom Their Presence May Come, Greetings:

WHEREAS: every two and a half minutes a person is raped in the United States and in

Michigan, over 70 percent of rape victims are under the age of 20; and

WHEREAS: sexual assault is an intolerable, violent crime with extensive short and long-

term implications for victims, their loved ones and to society as a whole; and

WHEREAS: elimination of sexual violence is achievable through change at the individual,

family, community, organization, and societal levels; and

WHEREAS: Sexual Assault Awareness Month is an excellent opportunity for citizens to

learn more about how to stop perpetration of sexual violence before it can start and to show support for the numerous organizations and individuals who provide critical advocacy, services, and assistance to sexual assault survivors.

NOW THEREFORE, I Michael McCauslin, Mayor of the City of Niles, Michigan, do hereby proclaim the month of April, in the year 2010, as

Sexual Assault Awareness Month
