Proclamation

WHEREAS, The African Diaspora Foundation (ADF) is committed to developing a coalition of national and international leaders and organizations to address critical issues concerning peace, nonviolence, and reconciliation in Africa

WHEREAS, the issue of peace embraces the deepest hopes of all peoples and remains humanity's guiding inspiration; and

WHEREAS, in 1981 the United Nations proclaimed that the International Day of Peace would be "devoted to commemorating and strengthening the ideals of peace both within and among all nations and peoples"; and

WHEREAS, the United Nations expanded the observance of the International Day of Peace in 2001 to include the call for a day of global ceasefire and non-violence, and invited all nations and people to honor a cessation of hostilities for the duration of the Day; and

WHEREAS, there is growing support among members of our foundation for the observance of the International Day of Peace, which affirms a vision of a world at peace, and fosters cooperation among individuals, organizations and nations; and

WHEREAS, The African Diaspora Foundation is committed to join hands with the United Nations and people around the world in pledging its commitment to peace, democracy, Justice, reconciliation, cooperation for better world, non violence, dialogue among nations and to the Universal Declaration of human rights, on this day and always; and
