Offered By Boston City Councillors Felix B. Arroyo, Sam Doon, Charles C. Pancey and Chuck Turner

Whereas: The issue of peace embraces the deepest hopes of all peoples and remains

humanity's guiding inspiration; and

Whereas: In 1981 the United Nations proclaimed that an International Day of Peace be

"devoted to commemorating and strengthening the ideals of peace both within

and among all nations and peoples"; and

Whereas: The United Nations expanded the observance of the International Day of Peace in

2001 to include the call for a day of global ceasefire and non-violence; and

Whereas: There is growing support within the City for the observance of the International

Day of Peace, which affirms a vision of our world at peace and fosters

cooperation between individuals, organizations and nations; and

Whereas: The Boston City Council acknowledges the need to promote peace in Boston:

Therefore be it Resolved

That the Boston City Council does hereby declare

September 21, 2006

UN International Day of Peace

in the City of Boston; that this Resolution be signed by the President of the City Council and attested to and a copy thereof transmitted by the Clerk of the City of Boston.
