WHEREAS, these days remind everyone of the importance of world peace and provide the opportunity for all to participate in peace-building activities:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICHARD M. DALEY, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO, do hereby proclaim September 7 - 21, 2006, to be PEACE DAYS IN CHICAGO and encourage everyone to share in the One Minute of Silence for World Peace.
